## 50 Million Tree Program

- The goal of the 50 Million Tree Program is plant 50 million trees across Ontario by 2025.
- Funding is available to help reduce the cost of larger scale tree planting.
- 10<sup>th</sup> year anniversary
   — to date over 24 million trees have been planted on about 4,000 properties.



### 50 Million Tree Program

#### Landowner Eligibility

- Minimum: 1 hectare (2.5 acres) or windbreaks of 1,500 trees;
- Eligible land non-forested & productive land;
- Landowner agrees to protect the trees for 15 years; and



Landowner assumes some of the costs of the tree planting.

The Ontario Tree Marker Training teaches the proper use of the silvicultural systems used in Ontario. I.e., 'cut &leave' decisions for individual trees based on their: growth, health & product potential; ability to provide seed; & wildlife benefits.

E-learning modules are available online to serve as a primer to meet the learning objectives of the marking course.



## Heritage Tree Program

#### What is a Heritage Tree?

Recognition is based on a trees' historical, cultural or social significance as well as consideration given for distinctness in size, form, age and rarity.

Heritage Trees have to be associated with a historic person or event, or may be growing on land that is historically significant.

- ★ Today 82,000+ ha of private forests are certified including
  - **★** 14 community forests
  - 2 forest owner groups with 109 private forest owners
  - **★** 2 commercial forest owners
  - **★** 3 independent forest managers
  - ♣ 5 maple syrup producers









- ♣ Partnership EOMF and Bluesource Canada to develop offsets for Improved Forest Management (IFM) Projects on Community Forests
- ♣ Bluesource has been a project developer of carbon projects for over 20 years and specializes in IFM projects
- **♣** New opportunities for Community Forests
  - **★** Extra revenues
  - ♣ Ensure forest cover remains over long-term
  - ♣ Funds back into IFM

Eastern Ontario Model Forest





## Partnerships in Action: Tree Planting



Band spray and scribe Hand tree planting site

- Provide significant funding to landowners to meet tree planting objectives.
- Provides full-service planting operations (site prep, planting, tending)
- Typical costs for landowners is \$0.15/tree (equals \$120/acre)



## Promoting our Forests: Woodlot Advisory Service



Do you own at least 4 hectares of forested land within the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry or Prescott and Russell?


- Free site visits
- \$500 grants available for the completion of Forest Management Plans (MFTIP)
